With reference to the subject and reference cited 3<sup>rd</sup> above, it is to inform that, the Class work for I/III/V Semesters for the A.Y. 2021-22 commences from **01-09-2021** and the Orientation Programme for I Semester commences from **01-09-2021 to 04-09-2021 (4 days)**. Therefore, all the Principals of Govt/Aided/Unaided/II shift Polytechnics in Engineering colleges are informed to instruct the respective Head of Sections to enter the Aadhar details of the newly admitted students who are admitted during the Academic Year 2021-22 in SBTET website [www.sbtet.telangana.gov.in](http://www.sbtet.telangana.gov.in) -- > College Login head login and generate PIN for students duly verifying the aadhar data of the Students reported.

The Principals are requested to instruct the concerned Head of Sections to login at the above link and enter the Aadhar number of the newly admitted students and make them Aadhar authenticate by using USB Biometric authentication device. Once the student is authenticated with Aadhar, Student PIN number and Biometric Attendee ID will be generated in the system, and then the Head of Section concerned should direct the students to give Biometric attendance regularly with the newly generated Biometric attendee ID in BMS machine.

In this connection, it is informed that, the students have to give their attendance through POS devices /IRIS devices with a minimum gap of 6 hours in between two punches. If the gap between the two punches is less than 3 hours or there is a single punch, it will be treated as absent and if the gap between 3 hours to less than 6 hours, it will be treated as half day present.

Further the Principals of Govt/Aided/Unaided/II shift Polytechnics in Engineering colleges/Pharmacy Institutions are informed to complete the Re-admissions (if any) within 15 days for all Diplomas' and 30 days for Diploma in Pharmacy. It is also informed to select the readmission tab in college login <https://sbtet.telangana.gov.in/> - college login and readmit the students and complete the KYC process and then only the attendance of the students will be enabled and permission will be given to enter marks of the students concerned.

The Principals are requested to pay personal attention on Pin Generation/Biometric Attendance/Readmission and completion of syllabus as per the Academic Calendar enclosed.
